

DIED EATING MARSHMALLOWS.

Seven-Year-Old Girl's Strange Fate Caused the Arrest of Miss Jennie Cohen at Albany.

ALBANY, July 31.—Miss Jennie Cohen, twenty-four years old, is being held pending an investigation by Coroner Van Guysling into the death of Rebecca Boschefski, aged seven. Miss Cohen was passing along Hamilton Street, eating marshmallows from a bag. Several children at play begged her for some of the confections, and she distributed the candy among them.

Rebecca Boschefski crammed hers into her mouth and ran. She fell in her father's store on Green Street. Her mother picked her up, but could not tell what was the matter. The child died before the arrival of a physician. Miss Cohen says she gave the candy with good intentions.
